

Grasses & Grazers of Botswana and the surrounding savanna Veronica Roodt

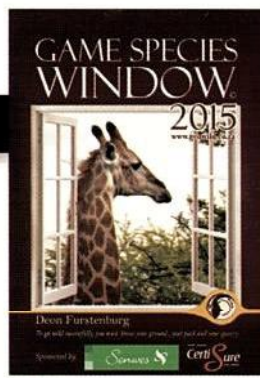
An accessible reference to the grasses and grazers of this region, Veronica Roodt's book details the fascinating ways in which these plants and animals have evolved together. The book covers:

- some 100 grass species (includes sketches and photographs of each species) that are preferred livestock and wild game fodder and that serve as indicators of veld condition
- the role of grasses in the food chain
- grass anatomy and growth
- how grazers have evolved to survive on grasses, both physically and in terms of their behaviour
- significant grazers that occur in the region and that play a vital role in shaping the savanna biome
- effective grassland management practices.

Nature lovers, farmers, students and tourists who seek an in-depth look at the interactions between grasses and the grazers that depend on them for life, can take a look at this invaluable guide.

Veronica Roodt has a BSc in botany and zoology and a BSc (Hons) in animal physiology. For many years she has conducted research on wildlife, plants and their uses from her base in a tented bush camp in the Okavango Delta in Botswana. She is the author of a number of books and maps.

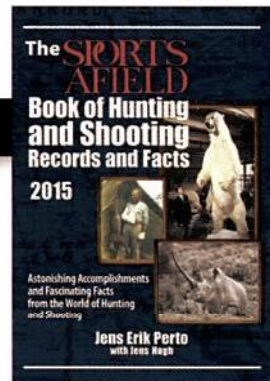
Game Species Window 2015 Deon Furstenburg

This is a user-friendly, easily accessible, comprehensive collection of scientific biological information on 56 animal species of the Southern African continent. This e-book is intended as an educational tool to assist the **wildlife owner** in the management and production of his game animals, **students**, and **researchers** in compiling assignments and projects, **politicians** and **government officials** in formulating legislation, **wildlife tourists** in acquiring reliable animal information, and the **hunter** in planning his trips and expeditions. The information can be regarded as a benchmark for decision making, planning and the management of game animals.

The content includes information on the identification and description of animals, taxonomy, distribution, habitat requirements, spoor, trophy measurements, behaviour, feeding and nutrition, territory and home range, social structure, reproduction, production, management and hunting, as well as live animal sale prices up to 2008. The information is based mainly on naturally occurring, free-roaming animals.

The *Game Species Window* was first developed as a series of articles published in **GAME & HUNT** and had to be repeated three times due to public request. It was also published in the *SA HUNTER / JAGTER* magazine and again in part in the *WILDLAND* magazine. In 2006 it appeared on compact disk as *THE WILDLIFE CD* and now as an e-book.

The author, Deon Furstenburg, is well known as an expert wildlife ecologist and game production scientist with 34 years' experience.
